Safeguarding Women Health Concerns in Poor Localities/Villages

Focused work at the grassroots on increasing awareness on women/community health issues , facilitating access to healthcare centers and addressing stigma and discrimination related to HIV-AIDS and Reproductive Health. Regular activities included seminars, health talks and women's meeting among Women Fellowship Group of Lahore Diocese Church of Pakistan.



Field Staff Working in Challenging Environment:

Community Workers carry out door to door visits in the far flung villages to reach out to those confronting health challenges and also perform as a link between patient and a hospital.

Field staff is equipped with First Aid Training Box and Resource Materials in national language as brief guide book, leaflets and brochures on health issues to carry forward the healthcare message.



Training Workshops

Capacity Building Workshops are being organized for Women Fellowship Groups, Youth Groups, Priests, Catchists and Project Staff on HIV-AIDS, Hepatitis, First Aid Disaster Management and Emergency Relief.
